

**IIHMR University, Jaipur**  
**Scholarship Policy for students of MBA (HM/PM/RM)**  
**admitted during the academic year 2018 – 2020**  
**Late Shri P D Agarwal Scholarship**

IIHMR University, Jaipur envisages granting scholarships to prospective students based on academic merit. The policy/guidelines for granting scholarships are as under:

1. **Name of Scholarship:** Late Shri P D Agarwal Scholarship
2. **Number of Scholarships:** 72 (Total number of scholarships will not exceed this number under any circumstances.)

3. **Eligibility Criteria Scholarship:**
  - a. **For Medical Graduates (MBBS and Above):** Candidates who have secured a minimum of 60% marks in aggregate in graduation.
  - b. **For BDS & Non-Medical Graduates:** Candidates who have secured a minimum of 70% marks in aggregate in graduation.
4. **Selection for Scholarship:**
  - a. The scholarships will be awarded as per the merit list which ranks prospective students based upon aggregate marks received in their graduation. First preference will be given to medical graduates (MBBS & above) even if they fall below in the merit list. Remaining scholarships will be awarded as per the merit list of BDS & non-medical students.
  - b. The Academic Department of the University is responsible for announcing results and informing to prospective and enrolled students about the scholarship policy and its criteria.



**5. Amount of Scholarship:**

- a. Each student who is awarded the scholarship will receive a total amount of Rs. 50,000/- [Rupees fifty thousand only]. The total scholarship amount will be distributed in two installments:
    - i. Rs. 25,000/- will be awarded during the First Year of the MBA program (2018-2019) adjusted in the 3<sup>rd</sup> fee installment, and
    - ii. Rs. 25,000/- will be awarded during the Second Year of the MBA program (2019-2020) adjusted in the 5<sup>th</sup> fee installment, if the student maintains passing marks in all the examinations of the First Year of MBA program.
  - b. The amount of scholarship as described above will not be disbursed directly to the student.
6. **Scholarship Application:** There is no need to apply for the scholarship. The application form submitted for admission for the MBA program by the prospective students will serve as the application for the scholarship.
7. **Declarations:** The University reserves the right to add, withdraw or modify any of the criteria, amount and count for all scholarship details mentioned above at any time. The Academic Department of the University will maintain the records related to the grant of scholarships.

**Note:** Besides the above scholarships, a tuition fee waiver for all **serving defense personnel** will be allowed at 40% of the tuition fee for the duration of the MBA program. This exemption is based on their employment and is not related to the scholarship policy described above.
