*IIHMR University invites applications for its
PhD Programme 2017*

It is a doctoral program in the health sector with a multidisciplinary focus. The areas include public health, health and hospital management, pharmaceutical management, rural management, nursing management, population and reproductive health, health economics and finance, urban health, rural health, health nutrition, health communication and behavior change, information technology in the health sector, health systems, food security and nutrition and related areas.

Eligibility

Master's Degree or Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM) of 2 Years duration from a UGC/AICTE recognized institution or university, with at least 55% marks (or equivalent grade) and 50% for SC and ST candidates.



Admission Process : The admission process will include three steps: Screening of applications, IIHMR Research Aptitude Test (IRAT) and Personal Interview.

IIHMR Research Aptitude Test (IRAT): The IIHMR University will conduct a Research Aptitude Test for eligible candidates. IRAT will be a written test consisting of multiple choice questions testing candidates' English language proficiency, reasoning, basic quantitative analysis and research aptitude.

Exemption from IRAT : UGC / CSIR qualified JRF & NET in Management or related subjects.

Last date of submission of Application - 15 January 2017
Date of IRAT and Personal Interview - 24-25, February 2017
Commencement of session - 1 April 2017
