**A Brief Report on Training for April 2018 - March 2019**

The IIHMR University, Jaipur is a leading University in the country for skill development to improve the management practices in health sector. The training and capacity building efforts of the university benefited huge number of policy makers, advisors, hospital managers, health managers, planners, decision-makers, and pharmaceutical professionals at national and international levels to improve the leadership and management skills.

During April 2018 - March 2019, we have conducted 30 MDPs/Training Programmes/Workshops and able to attract 1180 participants (National: 1086 and International: 94). The international participants were from Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, England, Ethiopia Ghana, Kiribati, Lao PDR, Myanmar, Malaysia, Nepal, Nigeria, Sierra-Leone, Somalia, Sudan, Tanzania, Timor-Leste, UAE, USA and the national participants were from Assam, Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Delhi, Gujarat, Haryana, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Mizoram, Punjab Rajasthan, Sikkim, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal.

- Leadership and Strategic Management in Healthcare for Senior Management Executive at Goa:** The Four Day High Value programme was held during September 25-28, 2018 at Goa, India. The objective of the programme was to strengthen leadership and managerial competencies of senior management professionals. It was designed to transform senior management executives into high performing leaders who can capitalize on existing opportunities and organizational strength for improved management. - Operation Management in Hospitals:** The three days Management Development Programme during November 16-18, 2018. The general objective of the Programmeme is to make hospital & health managers. Specific objectives of the Programmeme are, to evaluate hospital projects with PERT/CPM techniques, to understand forecasting techniques in health care operations, to help participants understand the inventory control techniques, to understand the quality management and quality control techniques in hospitals, to help participants understand queuing model formulations in hospital services, to train the participants on decision sciences software for solving the OM problems. In all there are 15 participants from two countries India and Nepal respectively. The participants are from Government, and Non-Governmental agencies. The Objective of the programme was Understand the concept and premises of emotional intelligence, envision the multi-modality environs in which they thrive in life and appreciate emotional anchoring to their response to diversity over their life space, use of emotional intelligence for making informed choices, deploy the learnings of new perspective to their managerial and leadership roles, demonstrate chosen competencies related to deal with past and present emotional baggage and design 'happy' futures. - **Logistic Management of Vaccines with Special Focus on Strengthening Cold Chain: -** This MDP programme was of 5- day and conducted during April 09-13, 2018. The major objective of the training to comprehend and establish a comprehensive framework for vaccines management for achieving the immunization programmes objectives; to facilitate technical and operational guidance for strengthening the supply chain for vaccines and immunization related equipment's in the healthcare programmes; to effectively manage the cold chain system for achieving the immunization programmes deliverables. In all we received 27 participants Bhutan, India, Kiribati, Somalia, Sudan, Nigeria. The participants were nominated by UNICEF, Ministry of Health, National Primary Healthcare Development Agency (N.P.H.C.D.A.), National Health Mission, Plasma Gen Biosciences Pvt. Ltd., Save the Children and Impart. The programme was coordinated by Dr. Saurabh Kumar, Assistant Professor, SPM, IIHMR University, Jaipur.
- **Access to Essential Medicines in Low and Middle-Income Countries: -** This programme was of 5-day and conducted during April 16-20, 2018. The objective of the programme was to understand the concepts of access to essential medicine with their objectives, effective management and good governance to improve the performance and also to learn about various challenges in pharmaceutical management regarding effective public pharmaceutical supply, financial sustainability and regulating quality safety and efficiency of medicines. We received one nomination from National Leprosy Tuberculosis Control Programme, Sierra Leone. The programme was conducted by Mr. Abhishek Dadhich, Assistant Professor, SPM, IIHMR University, Jaipur.
- **Pharmacoepidemiology and Drug Safety: -** The programme was of 5-day duration and conducted during April 23-27, 2018. The objective of the programme was to understand different aspects of pharmacoepidemiology in practice, understand about the pharmacoepidemiologic study designs, to assess the effectiveness of drugs; understand different techniques used to study the patterns and determinants of drug utilization; understand issues regarding risks and benefits of drug use in humans including the cause, manifestations and consequences of adverse drug effects (ADEs). introduce participants to fundamental statistical, compliance and regulations concepts and methods. We received two participants from National Hospital Guido Valadares- Timor-Liste. The programmeme was coordinated by Mr. Rahul Sharma Assistant Professor, SPM, IIHMR University, Jaipur.
- **Patient Medication Safety and Quality Management:** The programme was organized during September 10-14, 2018. The objective of the programme was to enable participants, understand the concepts and need of medication safety culture in organization, to develop error reduction strategies around the use of high-alert medications, to understand effective communication techniques and human error that may impact on patient medication safety also to create a patient medication safety culture in hospitals. In all we received four participants from NHM Maharashtra and Jigmi Dorji National Referral

Hospital, Bhutan respectively. Assistant Professor Mr. Abhishek Dadhich coordinated the programme.

- **Safeguarding Quality of Medicine in Resource Limited Setting:** The programme was organized during September 24-28, 2018. The specific objectives of the programme was to provide technical guidance for establishing a robust quality assurance framework for ensuring good quality of medicines despite limited human and financial resources, to comprehend key concepts and principles pertaining to quality of medicines, To Underline the key issues and challenges affecting the quality of medicines in the existing healthcare systems and identifying the ways to mitigate the quality issues.
